We've opened up more spots in MLW's summer leadership programs for Middle and High School students! All programs take place at the University of Maryland Baltimore County (UMBC).

- For rising 6th-8th graders - Middle School Experience in Leadership (July 21-27) focuses on basic leadership skills and helping students recognize opportunities for leadership in their schools and communities.
- For rising 7th-9th graders - Bridge (July 14-20) is an advanced level program for those who have attended MLW before or have equivalent leadership experience. As our smallest program, Bridge offers a great opportunity for a more personalized leadership journey.
- For rising 9th-12th graders - Senior High Workshops (July 28-August 3) focuses on the skills needed to work in diverse groups as well as helping students find their voice, power and purpose.
- For rising 7th-9th grade girls in Howard County only - Journey (July 14-20) is a program designed to help young women with the leadership skills needed to navigate middle school and the transition to high school.
